Forecast timetable: 22 November 2023

- 1.1 On 5 September the Chancellor requested the next Office for Budget Responsibility (OBR) forecast to be published on 22 November, alongside the Government's Autumn Statement. As provided for by the Charter for Budget Responsibility and Memorandum of Understanding that governs the forecasting process,¹ the OBR agreed the timetable for this forecast with the Forecast Liaison Group on 19 September.²
- 1.2 The timetable for transmitting forecast rounds from the OBR to the Chancellor to inform his policy decisions and for publishing the final *Economic and fiscal outlook* is as follows:

Wednesday 4 October: Round 1

Thursday 19 October: Round 2

Tuesday 31 October: Round 3

• Tuesday 7 November: Round 4

Friday 17 November: Round 5

Wednesday 22 November: Economic and fiscal outlook published

1.3 Forecast rounds will be transmitted to the Chancellor at the end of the working day. All rounds of the forecast up to and including Round 3 will be 'pre-measures' rounds. Subsequent rounds will combine the 'pre-measures' forecast with the economic and fiscal implications of any new policy measures notified to the OBR by the Treasury so that they are ready to be included in a final, post-measures forecast published on 22 November.
