Dear Dame Meg,

I would like to offer my sincere apology to you and other Members of Parliament that the OBR inadvertently made it possible to access the November 2025 *Economic and fiscal outlook* this morning and for the disruption this has caused. I recognise the impact this has had, and I take full responsibility on behalf of the OBR.

I have initiated an investigation into how this happened which will also identify the actions required to ensure that it does not happen again. The investigation will be overseen by Baroness Sarah Hogg, Chair of the OBR's Oversight Board, and report to the Treasury and the Commons Treasury Committee, with expert input from Ciaran Martin, Professor at Oxford University and former CEO of the National Cyber Security Centre.

The report will be published as quickly as possible, and we will implement all of its recommendations in full.

I am copying this letter to the Chancellor of the Exchequer, the Permanent Secretary to the Treasury, the Chair of the OBR's Oversight Board, and Professor Martin.
